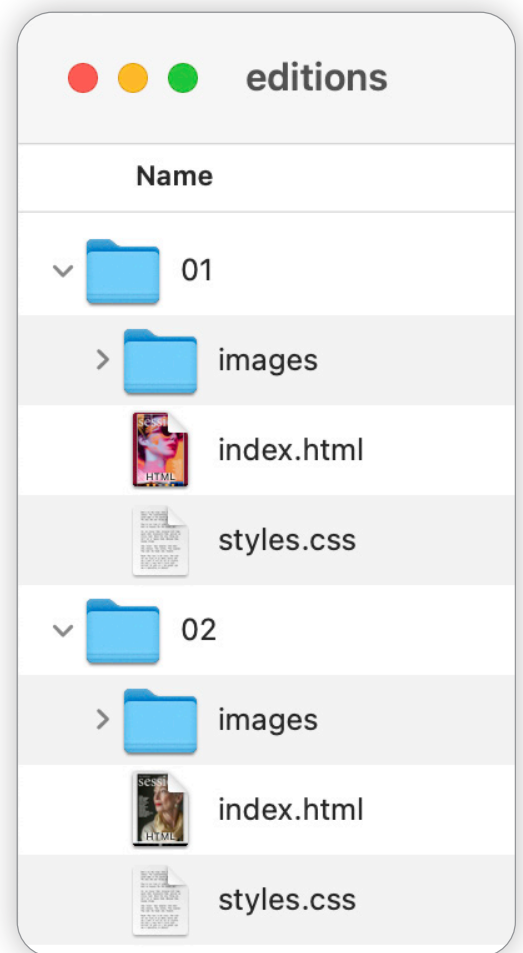


## Tips and tricks:

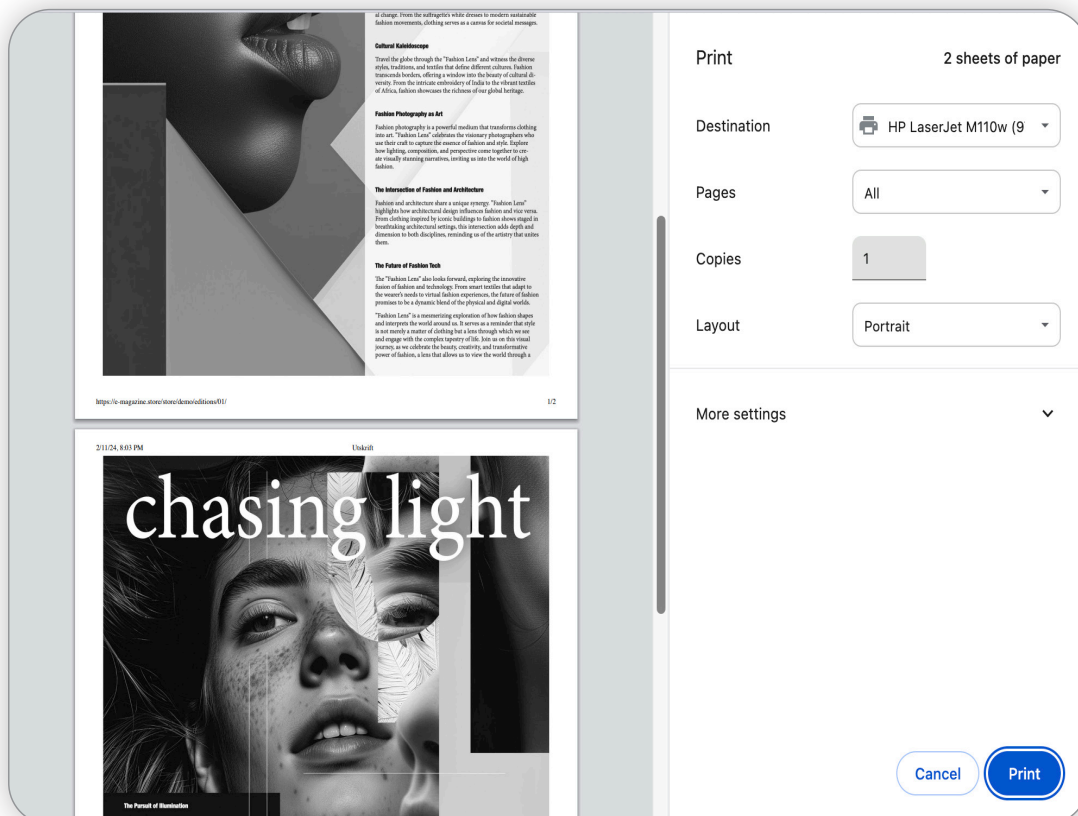
*By reusing a previous e-magazine, you can publish a new e-magazine in no time.*

Often, we want to use a consistent design across different publications within the same title. Here, you can do it in two ways;

- Either you choose to save your CSS file (styles.css) in a folder that you name after the e-magazine's name. (You simply use your CSS file as a template).
- You can also choose to copy the folder from a previous issue (e.g., the folder 01), then delete the images from the "images" folder, insert your new images there instead, and rename the folder to 02 (or whatever sequence is currently relevant). However, this requires that you have the same number of pages and title as the previous issue. Otherwise, you just create a new index.html file.



## Adapt your images to the correct printing sizes.



To ensure your readers can print the pages correctly, it is important that you prepare your images so that they correspond to a printable paper size, such as A4 or A3.
